Structure of Psalm 30:

Outburst of praise #1 verses 1-5
Confession of over-confidence verses 6-10
Outburst of praise #2 verses 11-12

After the night that brings weeping, then in the morning God restores our joy as we extol Him and singing praises to Him!

2 Samuel 5:9-10 and 2 Samuel 8:13-14

Psalm 6 prayer requests are connected to Psalm 30 answers!

6:2 Be gracious to me/lanquishing/heal me	30:2 You have healed me!
6:5 Sheol = no remembrance of God	30:3 brought up from Sheol
6:5 Sheol = who will give you praise?	30:9 in pit, no praise to God
6:2-3, David's soul greatly troubled	30:7 David was dismayed
Ps. 6, clearly fulfilled in Christ	Ps.30,same:completed in Christ

1. Our spiritual alertness shows Christ's resurrection triumph. (v.1-3)

Romans 1:21 Luke 17 story of ten lepers.
Matthew 27:43

2. We give thanks for God's tendency with us – He lovingly and quickly applies Christ's 'glorious morning' resurrection to us. (v.4-5)

Romans 6:5
Colossians 3:1-3
John 16:20-22
2 Corinthians 4:17
Psalm 126:5-6
2 Corinthians 4:17-18, in J.B.Phillips translation/paraphrase.

3. When we are faltering, God again applies favor to us through Christ's resurrection, and it is like being saved from God's wrath. (v.6-7)

Psalm 104:27-29
Numbers 6:24-26
1 Corinthians 10:12-14
Hebrews 12:28

4. For God to apply resurrection life to us is necessary for the worship of God to be conducted. (v.8-10)

Hymn 460, Amazing Grace, stanza 3, 'tis grace has brought me safe thus far, and grace will lead me home.

5. We who now live by the resurrection are consequently joyful. (v.11-12)

1 Peter 2:9

Conclusion: Praise the Lord at all times, for He always deals with us for our good.
